I hope this email finds you well and enjoying the milder autumn weather. There is new content about bookings in this newsletter, so please be sure to read it through.

Priority Bookings

This year has seen a large number of requests for bookings for the 2025 ski season. The Board are pleased to advise that all members' requests for winter bookings have now been processed and members notified.

As a result of the heavy demand for rooms, the lodge is fully booked for most of July and August. However, there are rooms available as per below:

- 9 June to 6 July – several rooms are available
- Week starting 20 July – 2 rooms available
- 24 August onwards – several rooms are available

Bookings for winter are now to be made directly through our online booking system or by contacting Mel at the lodge hahnenkammlodge@ymail.com.

CHANGE OF MIND BOOKINGS:

The demand for rooms in our very short ski season is very high, particularly for peak weeks. Our booking officer does his best to allocate rooms fairly, however at times will not be able to allocate a room in the preferred week, or pair groups of people who wish to ski together.

Unfortunately, an increasing number of members, upon being successful in their booking request, change their mind and decide not to progress with the booking. This results in weeks that were originally sought by other members suddenly becoming available.

The Board requests that you carefully consider the week that you wish to book. Going forward, if you cancel your week once it has been confirmed, a 10% fee will be charged. This will commence 1 May 2025.

Lodge Renovations

Additional sound proofing has been placed in key areas through the dining room to assist with noise issues. Subject to some soft furnishing and finishes, stage 1 of the lodge renovations is now complete. The Board are now in the process of planning Stage 2.

Clarification on members' rates

With many members' children now having families of their own, there has been some confusion with regards to what rate is applicable when making bookings. The Board wish to clarify the rates.

- Each member is entitled to bring a spouse / partner at members rates
- Members' children are entitled to bring a spouse / partner at members rates
- Members' grandchildren are charged at members rates if they come with the member otherwise at accompanied guest rates if they only come with their parents.
- Members' children may bring one guest at members rates if the guest is aged 18 – 24 years.
- Priority for rooms will always be given to members. Members who submit booking requests in peak periods with additional requests for rooms for friends will not be prioritised. There will be no guarantee that rooms will be allocated for non-members.

Message from the Board on Lodge Usage

Members are reminded that each Member is responsible for the conduct of all family and guests (including children) staying at the Lodge. Please check lodge rules that are on the back of the door in each room to ensure that all requirements are met during your stay, and prior to vacating your room.
