NEWSLETTER – COVID 19 update

Dear Members,

We hope you are having a good week and enjoying the gradual relaxing of restrictions that is occurring. Expectations are starting to look positive for a 2020 ski season, which is very exciting!

COVID – 19 update

The Board met this week to determine a COVID -19 opening plan for this season. The following points were discussed and agreed upon:

Government directives – 3 step opening plan:

- Currently regional travel is now allowed, and up to 10 guests will be able to access the lodge at any point in time.
- Stage 2 will allow for 20 guests to access the lodge.
- Stage 3 will allow for the lodge to operate at full capacity.

Expectations for guests:

- All guests will need to have the COVID app running at all times.
- Guests are not allowed at the lodge if they have a temperature, cold or flu like symptoms. They will be turned away.
- Temperatures will be checked on arrival. If temperature exceeds 37.5c, or if you are displaying cold and flu like symptoms, entry to the lodge will not be permitted.
- A declaration form will be required to be filled out on arrival, declaring that guests have no temperature, cold or flu like symptoms.
- Social distancing will need to be maintained at all times. Signage will be placed throughout the lodge indicating the maximum number of guests allowed in the area.
- Social distancing will need to be maintained when fitting boots in the morning, with no more than 2 people in the boot room at a time.
- Hand hygiene is required (washed /sanitized) prior to each meal.
- All common areas to be wiped down and sanitised after use by guests.
- Washing machine and drier to be wiped down and sanitised after use.
- Communal fridges – please wipe down handles after use.

Lodge precautions

- Hand sanitiser will be present at all entry points and in all common areas.
- Random temperature checks may occur during the stay.
- Social distancing will be maintained at mealtimes with tables being spread apart or two servings of meals occurring.
- The SPA, communal toilet and shower will be closed this season.

Members risks:

- Members and guests acknowledge they enter at their own risk. Should they contract COVID – 19, Hahnenkamm will not be responsible.
- If any guest comes down with COVID symptoms during their stay, they will be asked to leave as soon as possible, with no refund.
- If a guest is diagnosed as COVID – 19 positive, the lodge will close immediately, and everyone will be asked to leave and self-isolate for 14 days.

What if the government does not enforce Levels 2 or 3?

- Accommodation will be prioritised for members who booked in the priority period. Should numbers booked exceed numbers allowed, a ballot system will be used to determine who gets to use the lodge.

June Long Weekend – a message from Thredbo Resort

“Kosciuszko Thredbo welcome the lifting of the NSW travel ban, however, please note that **Thredbo Resort will not be opening the snow season for skiing and snowboarding over the June long weekend**. This means there will be no skiing/snowboarding or any opening weekend events in Thredbo over 5-8 June 2020.

Rest assured, we are continuing to work hard with Government authorities and snow industry partners to deliver a COVID safe season. We remain hopeful that we’ll be able to offer skiing and snowboarding this winter and are hoping to announce an Opening Date as soon as possible”.

AGM


