REFURBISHMENT NEWS

As announced at the AGM and Dinner in December 2008, we are proceeding with a staged refurbishment program to celebrate the 20th Anniversary of the Lodge.

Gary has been working hard managing the current program for completion before the start of the Winter Season. The work being done in this first stage includes renovation and repair of the spa area, refurbishment of the bathrooms, replacement of curtains with roller blinds, new bedroom linen and some general paintings and decorating.

Many thanks to Gary and we are looking forward to enjoying the fruits of his labours.

EARLY SNOW!

Snow still remains on the upper slopes and main range following very good falls late in April. Thredbo snow-making is scheduled to commence around 24th May with suitable temperatures. Early predictions indicate some warmer air flows over the next few weeks followed by the possibility of a low system moving in and light snowfalls around the June long weekend.

Following further work in the off season, Thredbo's snowmaking system is the largest in the Southern Hemisphere, covering more than 70 hectares of trails for all levels. This year \$2 million was spent on adding automated snow guns to the True Blue run, Meadows on the Supertrail, Little Beauty and up as far as the tree line on Antons and Sponars.
