Dear Members,

I hope this email finds you well and looking forward to the 2026 winter season. This newsletter contains some important updates about bookings for 2026, please take time to read it.

Priority Bookings

This year has seen a record number of requests for bookings for the 2026 ski season, particularly in peak weeks. All members' requests for winter bookings have now been processed and members notified.

Bookings for winter are now to be made directly through our online booking system or by emailing your booking request to info@hahnenkamm.com.au.

Large non-member booking request

We have received a large non-member booking request for the weekend of 3 to 5 July or alternatively 26 to 28 June. As per the booking rule (6.5 (a) of the Club Rules) we are providing notice to you to allow you the opportunity to make a booking for either of these weekends before we accept this booking request. All booking requests will only be accepted by emailing a completed booking form to info@hahnenkamm.com.au by 23 April 2026.

Shoulder Season Part Week Bookings: 4 June to 27 June and 23 August to 5 October

We have opened the Shoulder season to part week bookings. Booking requests will only be accepted by emailing a completed booking form to info@hahnenkamm.com.au by 23 April 2026.

Peak season part week bookings will continue to only be accepted from 1 week before arrival.

Change of mind bookings:

The demand for rooms in our very short ski season is very high, particularly for peak weeks. Our booking officer does his best to allocate rooms fairly, however at times will not be able to allocate a room in the preferred week, or pair groups of people who wish to ski together.

Unfortunately, an increasing number of members, upon being successful in their booking request, change their mind and decide not to progress with the booking. This results in weeks that were originally sought by other members suddenly becoming available.

The Board requests that you carefully consider the week that you wish to book. If bookings are cancelled after they have been confirmed, the 10% cancellation fee provided for in the Club Rules will be charged.

Clarification on members' rates

With many members' children now having families of their own, there has been some confusion with regards to what rate is applicable when making bookings. The Board wishes to clarify the rates.

- Each member is entitled to bring a spouse / partner at members rates
- Members' children are entitled to bring a spouse / partner at members rates
- Members' grandchildren are charged at members rates if they come with the member otherwise at accompanied guest rates if they only come with their parents.
- Members' children may bring one guest at members rates if the guest is aged 18 – 24 years.
- Priority for rooms will always be given to members. Members who submit booking requests in peak periods with additional requests for rooms for friends will not be prioritised. There will be no guarantee that rooms will be allocated for non-members.

Message from the Board on Lodge Usage

Members are reminded that each Member is responsible for the conduct of all family and guests (including children) staying at the Lodge. Please check lodge rules that are on the back of the door in each room to ensure that all requirements are met during your stay, and prior to vacating your room.

AGM


